Leave granted.

By the impugned order dated 6th February, 2023, the High Court has not condoned the delay of 244 days in preferring an appeal under Section 37 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short, "the Arbitration Act"). In view of what is held in paragraph 63 of the decision of this Court in the case of *Government of Maharashtra (Water Resources Department) represented by Executive Engineer vs. Borse Brothers Engineers and Contractors Private Limited*¹, delay in filing an appeal under Section 37 of the Arbitration Act, beyond the stipulated period of limitation, can be condoned by way of an exception and not by way of a rule, by exercising the power under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963.

After having perused the grounds taken in the application for condonation of delay and the documents produced along with the application, we find that this case will have to be held as an supercoeption as observed in paragraph 63 of the aforesaid decision.

We, therefore, set aside the impugned order dated 6th February, 2023 and condone the delay in preferring the appeal under Section 37 of the Arbitration Act. We remit the appeal to the High Court for deciding afresh. The High Court will proceed to decide the appeal on its own merits.

The Appeal is, accordingly, allowed.
